MSH was retained by the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville to assist in the creation of a new comprehensive zoning by-law that would implement the Official Plan, the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan, Greenbelt Plan, and the Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe. As a result, this by-law is much more complex than the previous document, with



numerous new, and restructured zones. Dating from 1989, the Town's Zoning By-laws required a complete review and rewrite was required to ensure that the new By-law would reflect the current policy and sustainable zoning standards.

The project included a review of all recent official plan amendments, site specific zoning exceptions and new development standards in the town. Mapping was compiled from policy documents so that a comparison could be made to the development currently on the ground. The end result is a new comprehensive zoning by-law which reflects current Provincial, Regional and Town policy, and incorporates current sustainable zoning standards.
